Information we collect

When you use The Harlow Alliance Party (HAP) website we may ask for personal information in the following situations:

General Website Access

We collect information about your computer, including where available your IP address, operating system and browser type.

We also collect some information from software that allows us to understand how you arrive on our websites and use and navigate around them so we can improve the sites.

This is used for system administration and to ensure our website operates correctly. This is statistical data about our users' browsing actions and patterns, and does not identify any individual.

This website does not use cookies.

Membership Applications

When you apply for membership on our website, we collect your name, address, phone number and email address. This allows us to process your registration, send you a membership card and send you important HAP messages.

We need your address as you can only be a member of HAP if you live in Harlow.

If you are under 18 we will ask for your date of birth

This information is not shared with anyone else.

Contact Us

If you use the Contact Us link on the website we ask for your name, house number and postcode.

If you want us to respond electronically we require email address or phone number.

This information is not shared with anyone else.

Petitions

If you want to sign one of our petitions we ask for your name and email address. This is so we can thank you for signing and verify that you have only signed the petition once.

In addition we ask for your address so we can verify that the petition is relevant.

This information is not shared with anyone else unless we submit the petition to the relevant organisation.

Donations

If you make a donation to The Harlow Alliance Party we will ask for your email address so that we can thank you for your donation.

This information is not shared with anyone else.

Sharing your information with third parties

We do not share your personal information to third parties. However, please note that if necessary we will disclose your personal data in order to comply with any legal obligation.

We do not keep a record of your credit or debit card details in our systems.

How we protect your information

We follow strict security procedures in the storage and disclosure of information which you have given us, to prevent unauthorised access to, and loss, misuse or alteration of your personal information in accordance with UK data protection legislation. These include firewalls and virus-checking procedures.

Your rights regarding your Personal Information

Under the Data Protection law, you have a number of rights with respect to your personal information, which are:

Right of complaint to the Regulator for Data Protection
